

Background


- Nearly 90% of normal birth processes experience tears or perineal ruptures either with or without an episiotomy.
- Perineal rupture is an indirect cause of maternal death worldwide, which is caused by infection and postpartum hemorrhage. As many as 5% of maternal deaths in Indonesia are caused by obstetric trauma and perineal rupture.

Background


The incidence of perineal rupture experienced by birth mothers has a severe perineal trauma on the emotional, psychological and physical well-being of women, especially mothers in labor (Y vonne L. Huauck et al, 2014).

Delivery assistance by skilled and professional health workers continues to increase, reaching 72.4% in 2015 (Adrianzs, 2015).

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METHOD

- The study was a correlation study withstudy cross sectional approach. The sample in this study amounted to 64 respondents consisting of 32 midwives and 32 patients. The sampling technique used was total sampling.
- The instruments used were questionnaires and observation sheets. Analyzed by chi square statistical test
